Tennis is a sport we all love! The campers were coached to perfect their tennis skills and played different fun games along the way!

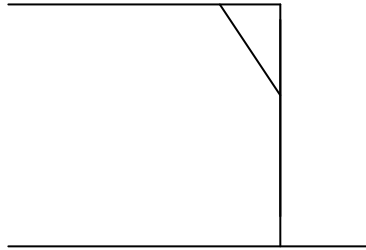
Many **Chocolate Creations** were made in this iShop. Campers had an opportunity to decorate their own chocolate cupcakes using incredible techniques!
